Why a Second Primary?



- ↪ The Ohio Redistricting Commission (Republican Supermajority) silenced our voices when they refused to draw fair maps for Statehouse elections.
- ↪ They repeatedly submitted unfair maps that drastically favor Republicans. The Ohio Supreme Court rejected their biased proposals FIVE times..
- ↪ Republicans succeeded in running out the clock, preventing us from having fair maps for a full primary in May 2022. Ohio voters were bulldozed into **wasting more than \$30 million** on this second primary in August.
- ↪ We are now gerrymandered (forced) into districts that are unfair, unconstitutional, and severely tip the playing field for Republicans.

THE COST OF CORRUPTION

Behind closed doors, before this gerrymandering nightmare, dishonest Ohio Republicans crafted the largest public corruption scandal in State history.

They passed legislation that pandered to corporate interests, betrayed our trust, and lined their own pockets. They then used this money to fund corrupt re-election campaigns and pay for bailouts for an out-of-state coal plant. For this, **Ohioans pay \$287,000 every single day**, reflected in increased electric bills every month.

Add this to the **\$30 million cost for the second primary election**, and imagine what we could do instead to improve the lives of Ohioans:

- Support libraries, food banks, and senior services
